Enclosed are the materials necessary to complete the ballot for the 2023 Board of Directors' Election.

The Materials Included Are:

1. A ballot to cast a vote for Three (3) individuals to fill three positions as Directors of the Edison Boat Club beginning January 1, 2024. All three (3) are for three-year-terms.
2. An inner SMALL plain white envelope to protect the confidentiality of the vote cast.
3. An outer white envelope addressed to the Secretary of The Edison Boat Club, William Wayland
4. Biographical sketches of each candidate if supplied.

PLEASE CAST YOUR BALLOT AS FOLLOWS:

1. Vote for no more than **three (3)** candidates by marking an "X" in the box to the left of each individual's name.
2. Enclose the marked ballot in SMALL plain white envelope and seal.
3. Place SMALL plain white envelope inside addressed white envelope.
4. ***Sign addressed envelope in the upper left hand corner and print your name underneath; if you do not sign the outer white envelope, your ballot cannot be identified and counted.**
5. Seal, stamp, and mail the pre-addressed white envelope.
