The balance of day two races were canceled just after the start of race 2 due to lack of wind.

Join us for a fun day sailing on the Detroit River. You can want to try sailing for the first time or can be an experienced sailor.




After we are done sailing, we can drive to Coriander Kitchen & Farm and have dinner. They will be serving dinner from 5:45 PM to 8 PM.
