

If arriving by boat, we request that Members call ahead to arrange dockage. Please note that reservations are not available on Friday evenings.

Enclosed with this letter is a card summarizing this reciprocal arrangement. We encourage you to display it prominently at your club, share this opportunity with your members, and promote the mutual benefits of our relationship.

All reciprocal club members must adhere to WYC's rules and regulations. Misconduct or failure to comply with WYC policies may result in the revocation of reciprocal privileges. Members must also be aware of the Club's dress code when visiting.
