NOTICE OF RACE

As part of our annual regatta, EBC will again host a series of Flying Scot races on August 15, 2026. Weather permitting, there will be a Spinnaker Race, Jam Race, Woman's Race, and Novice Race with awards given to the winning boats. EBC skippers must contact me before August 13, 2026 to reserve a boat and racing sails. Skippers are responsible for the preparation of their boat to race.

The event will be conducted according to the US Rules of Racing 2025-2028 and applicable DRYA and FS Interclub rules. **Entrants should email the details of the names of their club, skipper, crew, and sail number to the race committee before August 14, 2026 at mullinsme47@gmail.com.** They may also check-in at the race committee boat at the starting line at 12:30 PM on the day of the race. Racing will start as soon as possible thereafter. Boats which do not finish 45 minutes after the start of a race may be declared DNF. **See attached Memo of August 9, 2024**

The race is a point-to-point race. The starting line will be located in the area opposite Grayhaven Municipal Marina. A mark will be placed upriver opposite Riverview-Lakewood Park. A mark will be positioned downriver opposite Maharas-Gentry Park. A third mark is channel buoy G "113" at the entrance to the old Detroit Edison shipping channel. **On the day of the race the Committee will determine whether to start in an upriver direction taking all marks to starboard or downriver direction taking all marks to port. Please take notice, so that there is no misunderstanding, that the following rules will be observed in the upcoming race.

1. Women's Race. The competing boat shall be skippered by a woman. She may have a male crew, but the boat should be controlled by the woman which is the whole point of the race. *InterClub Class Rules Appendix A III*. **At this time the RC will understand this to mean she shall control the tiller at all times during the race.**

2. Novice Race. To be eligible a person must be a current novice of a club and **must have been incapable of skippering any sailing boat in a race prior the current season.** *Interclub Class Rules Appendix A III*

3 Protests. For this race all protests for infringements of the rules of racing shall primarily be signified by displaying a flag or lifejacket on the starboard [shroud.at](#) the first reasonable opportunity and keep it displayed until finishing and reported to the RC. **Within an hour after the finish of the final race of the day a written protest on blank forms provided by the RC must be submitted to the RC. for immediate consideration before results are announced.**

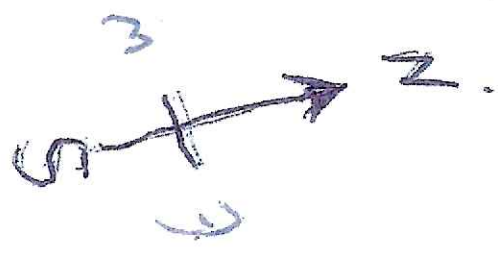
